Delivered using Blended and online learning with tutor support, including self-learning tasks, video presentations, quizzes, and polls. Use of online tutorials also using MS Teams and Zoom, these sessions can be recorded to enable the learners to review later.

Discussed at review and at end of lessons/sessions by the tutor.
